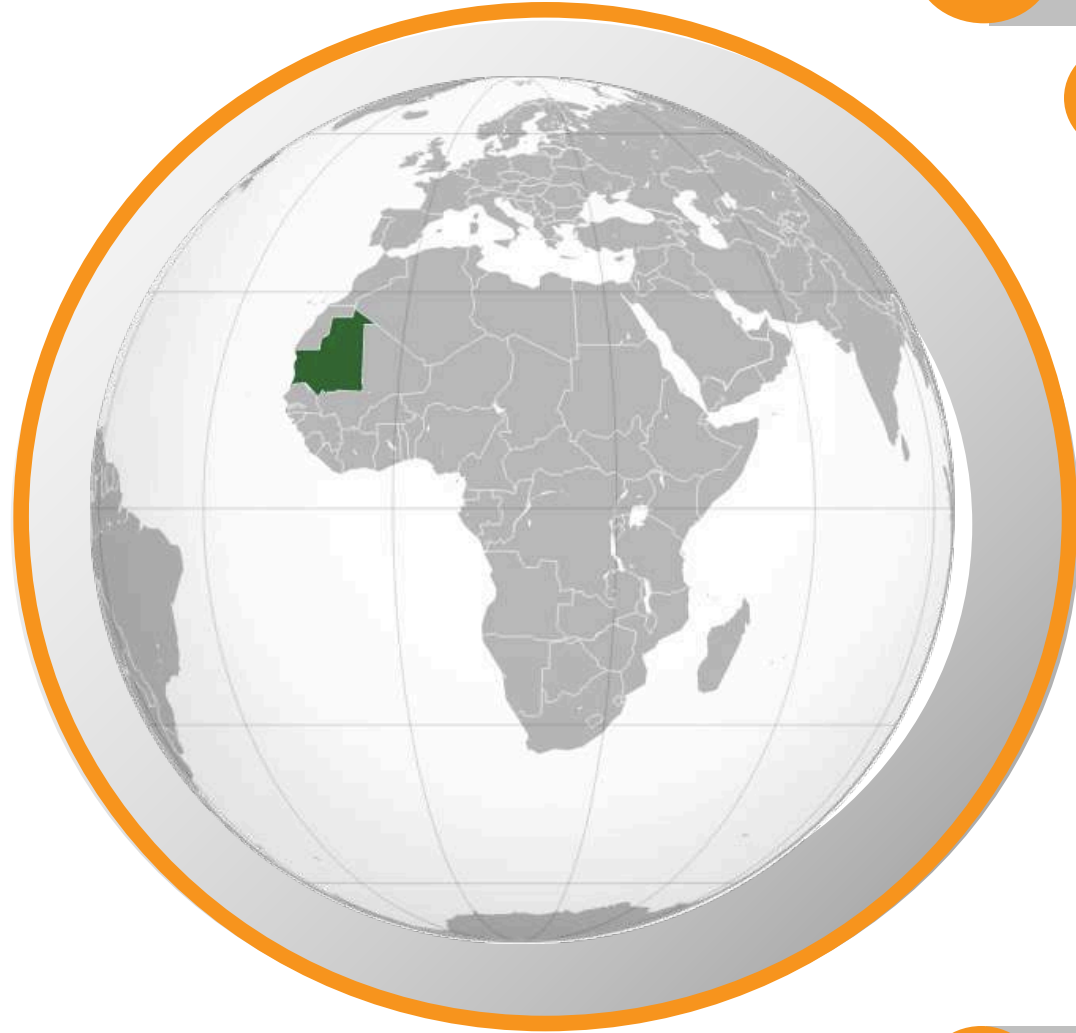

Building a business 2001 - 2009

- ✦ DB Schenker entered Mauritania in April 2001 and have been officially registered in 2002 to support the first oil and gas project in Mauritania : the Chinguitty field with Woodside.
- ✦ Schenker established the company as a safe and reliable partner in providing integrated logistics services in the oil & gas sector

Geographical Location

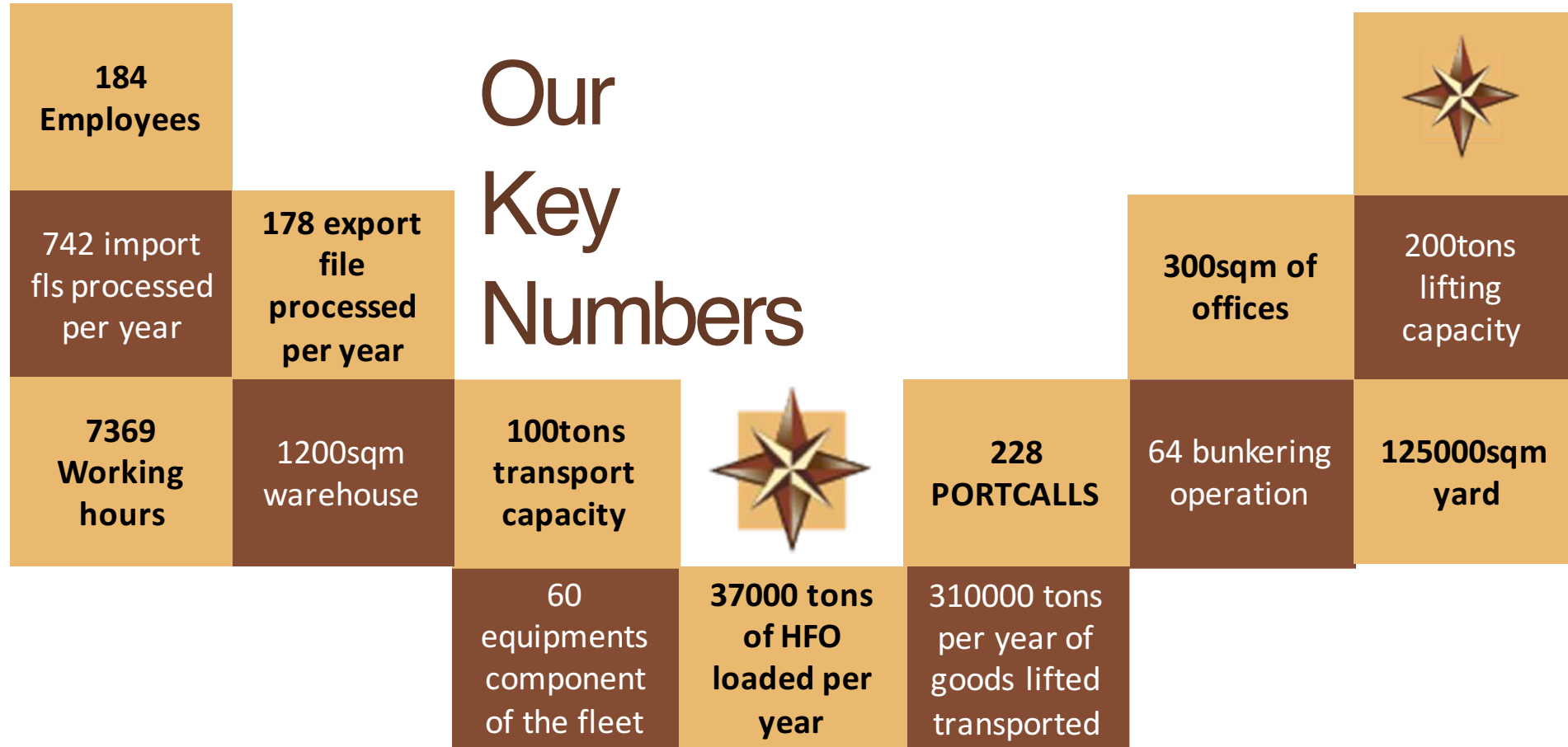
- ✧ Nouakchott city: Headquarter building of Maurilog with support services

- ✧ Cranes : 2 x 200t, 2 x 100t, 1 x 90t, 1 x 65t, 2 x 60t.



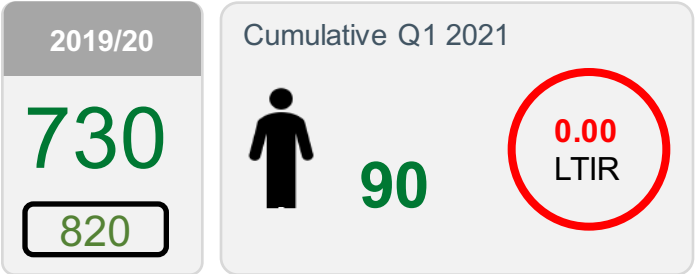

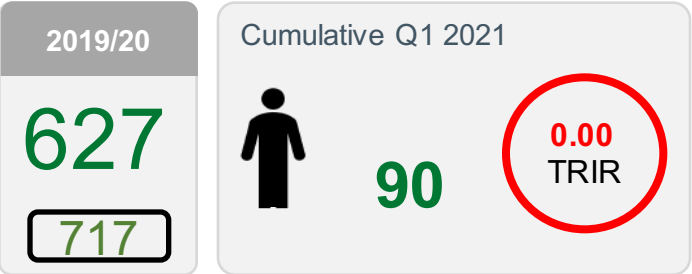


Safety Performance

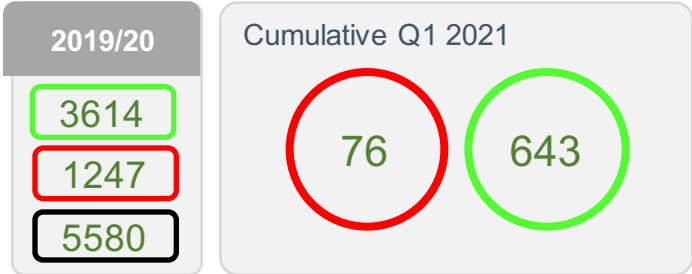
Lost Time Injuries Frequency Rate – 2019 to Date



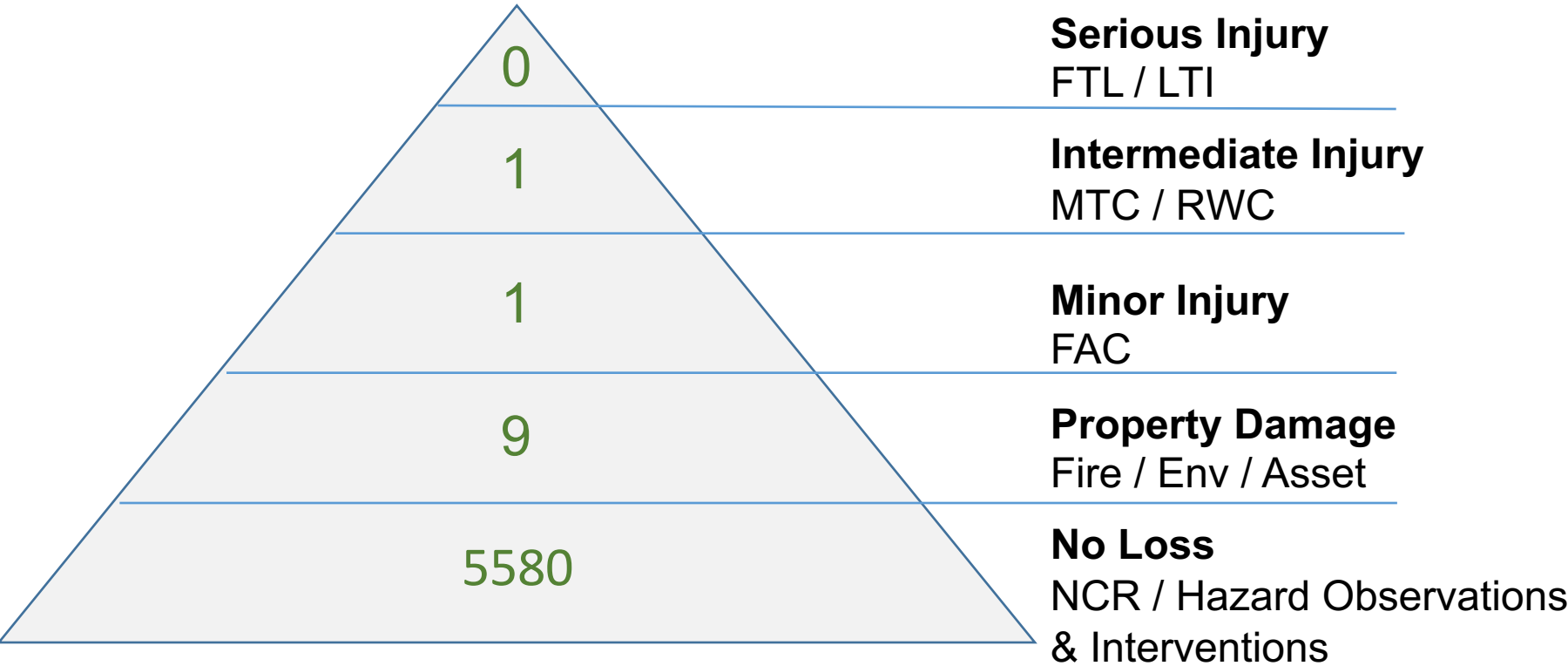
Total Recordable Injury Rate YTD – 2019 to Date

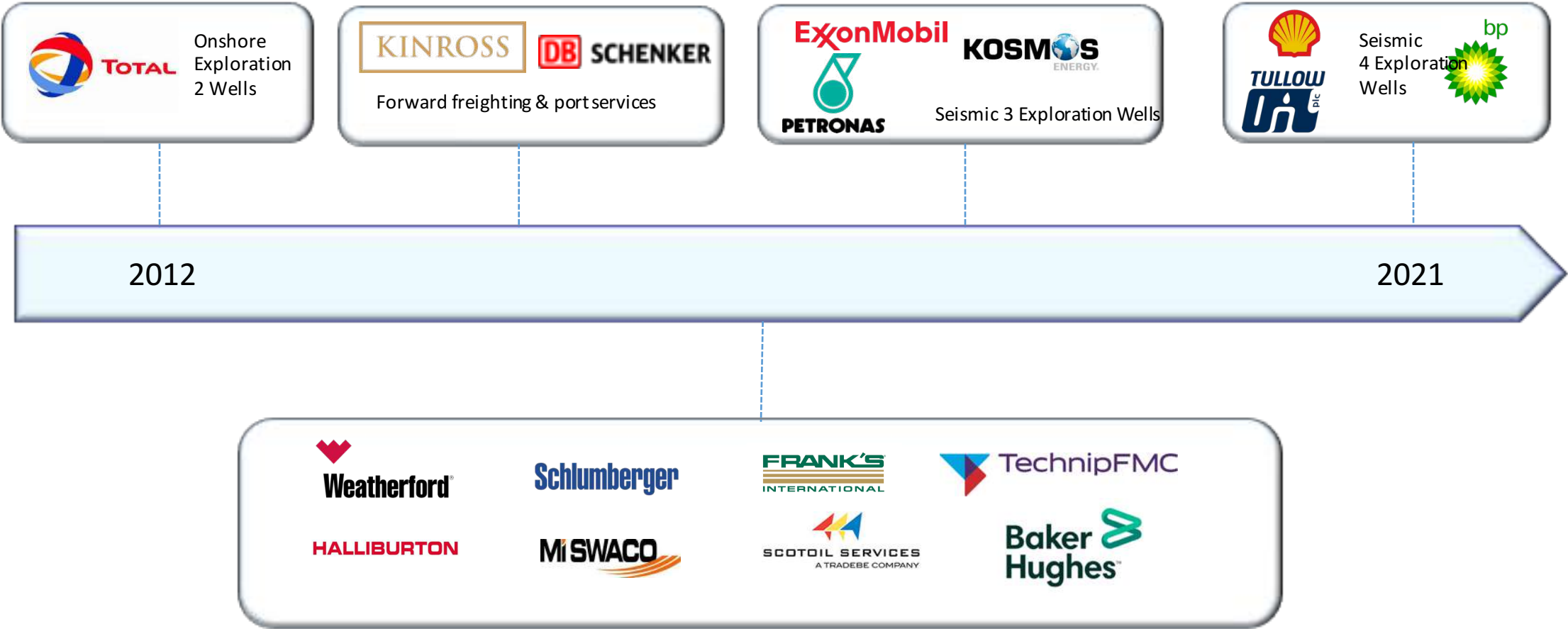
